Summer school registrations do not open until the end of May, but for your planning:

- KPR Summer School always takes place in July.
- For students who failed a course with a mark between 35% 49%, the program
 is for two weeks. Students are randomly assigned to either the first two weeks of
 July or the last two weeks in July. The summer school office determines this, not
 Clarke HS. They typically will not allow families to request which two weeks the
 student is to attend.
- For students whose final grade in a subject is below 35%, the student will need to attend the full, four week summer program.
- Summer school is open for students who wish to re-do a course they passed to improve their grade average, or to "fast-track" and take a course they haven't taken yet. In both of these cases, students will need to attend for the full four weeks.
- Summer school is usually offered at CCSS in Bowmanville (to be confirmed in May), and bussing is provided for KPR students to attend.
- There are some summer school courses offered via e-Learning. Course availability varies from year to year. Check the summer school bulletin board and Edsby in May for more information.
